The second newest faculty of <u>Charles University</u>, the Faculty of Social Sciences was founded in 1990, shortly after the Velvet Revolution. It soon became a regional center of teaching and research in Area Studies, Economics, International Studies, Journalism, Media Studies, Political Science and Sociology. The courses are instructed in English, but all students must complete a two-week intensive Czech Language course for 45 total contact hours.
